Extracts from the *Local Government Act 1995*

5.110. Dealing with complaint of minor breach

(6) The breach is to be dealt with by —

(b) ordering that —

(i) the person against whom the complaint was made be publicly censured as specified in the order; (ii) the person against whom the complaint was made apologise publicly as specified in the order; or

(iii) the person against whom the complaint was made undertake training as specified in the order;
or

(c) ordering 2 or more of the sanctions described in paragraph (b).

5.121. Register of certain complaints of minor breaches

(1) The complaints officer for each local government is required to maintain a register of complaints which records all complaints that result in action under section 5.110(6)(b) or (c).

(2) The register of complaints is to include, for each recorded complaint —

(a) the name of the council member about whom the complaint is made;

(b) the name of the person who makes the complaint;

(c) a description of the minor breach that the standards panel finds has occurred; and

(d) details of the action taken under section 5.110(6)(b) or (c).
