## Relics, Wrecks and Renos Photo Competition Terms and Conditions 2023

- 1. Information on how to enter, conditions of entry, and prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions.
- 2. Participation in this competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
- 3. Mundaring & Hills Historical Society (MHHS) staff/executive and their immediate family members are eligible to enter but are ineligible to win a prize.
- 4. Shire of Mundaring employees/councillors and their immediate family members are eligible to enter but are ineligible to win a prize.
- 5. Entry is free.
- 6. Photographs must be previously unpublished in a commercial publication.
- 7. Photographs previously submitted to SNAPPED in 2020, 2021, or 2022 are not eligible for entry in 2023.
- 8. Photographs must be of places within the Shire of Mundaring.
- 9. Photographs must be original, and the scanned submissions cannot be edited or altered, apart from cropping and straightening.
- 10. Photographs are to be submitted with a short description (50-word max) of the structures/buildings depicted in the photograph and their relationship to the Shire of Mundaring. Submissions must include the year the photo was taken or, if this is unknown, the decade, e.g. 1970s.
- 11. Photographs must be submitted in either a JPEG, PNG, or TIFF format and should be between 1MB and 10MB.
- 12. There is a limit of two (2) photograph entries per person in each category. Categories as follows:
  - Relics: Buildings or structures from the past.
  - Wrecks: A damaged or unrepairable building or structure.
  - Renos: A renovated historical building or structure still in use.
- 13. The "Wrecks" category winner will receive a gift voucher to spend at a local business of their choice, to the value of \$100, the "Relics" category winner will receive a gift voucher to spend at a local business of their choice, to the value of \$100, and the "Renos" category winner will receive a gift voucher to spend at a local business of their choice, to the value of \$100.
- 14. The entrant acknowledges and agrees that the results of the judging panel are final, and no correspondence shall be entered into.
- 15. Judging of entries will occur in the following way:

- A panel of three (3) judges will choose the winner of each of the three (3)
  categories. This panel will consist of one representative from the MHHS and one representative from the Shire of Mundaring and one independent representative.
- The winners of all three categories will be notified in person prior to the public announcement.
- The winners will be announced publicly on Friday Thursday 16 November via the MHHS's and Shire of Mundaring Libraries' Facebook and Instagram pages.
- 16. All entrants retain the copyright of their submitted images. However, submission of entries implies permission to upload the images to the MHHS's Local History Collection and to the Shire of Mundaring's Library Catalogue Digitised Images Collection. Entries may also be displayed on the MHHS's and the Shire of Mundaring's social media platforms and used in marketing and promotional material. Owners of photographs will be acknowledged when an image is used by either the MHHS or the Shire of Mundaring.
- 17. Prior to entering the competition, the entrant must have gained permission from the photograph's copyright owner to enter the photograph. The copyright owner is usually the person who took the photograph or, if they are deceased, the photographer's estate. Entries that do not have the necessary permission will be excluded. This permission is **not** required for photographs taken before 1955.
- 18. Entrants must complete one Entry Form per submitted image. Entries must be submitted via the Shire of Mundaring at www.mundaring.wa.gov.au.
