Community Recycling Centres

Shire of Mundaring has two Community Recycling Centres - formerly known as Waste Transfer Stations - located at Coppin Road, Mundaring and Mathieson Road, Chidlow.

Access to these Community Recycling Centres is limited to Shire of Mundaring residents, and can only be gained with a Community Recycling Centre entry pass.

If you are a tenant leasing a property, you will need to obtain the original entry pass from the owner or managing agent.

Requirements of Entry

No commercial waste, commercial vehicles or vehicles with a payload greater than two tonnes are allowed at either Community Recycling Centre.

The entry pass must be presented to the gate attendant at each visit. Proof of residence at the address on the entry pass may be requested. If so, please present your driver's licence for confirmation.

Loads must be sorted, to enable placement into the required areas. Directions and instructions from staff must be followed at all times.

Unauthorised use of the Community Recycling Centre entry pass may result in confiscation.

Entry Pass Entitlements

Unlimited disposal of certain recyclables, separated into different areas for recycling.
Unlimited green waste disposal.

Three entries for general waste to landfill. Additional entries for general waste to landfill may be purchased from the Shire Administration Centre located at 7000 Great Eastern Highway, Mundaring.

Bricks, concrete and rubble are accepted at Mathieson Road Community Recycling Centre only. Not accepted at Coppin Road.

Hazardous wastes such as paint and chemicals are not accepted at either Community Recycling Centre, but may be taken to Red Hill Waste Management Facility (9574-6235), limits apply. Asbestos containing materials, super six fencing or fibrous cement are not accepted at the Community Recycling Centres and will need to be disposed of at Red Hill Waste at a cost.

Tyres are accepted at both Coppin Road and Mathieson Road Community Recycling Centres, with a maximum of five per household accepted. Costs apply.

Grab n Go @ Mathieson Road and Coppin Road

Household items in good condition can be donated to and accessed by Shire residents at the Reuse Shop (at the discretion of the Community Recycling Centre attendant).

Accepted items include:

- » Clothing
- » Household goods Bicycles
- » Kitchenware (utensils, cutlery, crockery)
- » Garden items
- » Re-usable building materials (timber, tiles, doors, windows etc)
- » Tools
- » Sporting Equipment
- » Toys
- » Books
- » Magazines
- » Collectables/Antiques and Baths

Items not accepted include:

- » Computers
- » TV's
- » All Electronic Appliances
- » Mattresses
- » Sofas
- » Carpet
- » Tyres

Lost your pass or need a replacement?

A replacement entry pass can be issued to property owners or tenants for a fee. Please be aware, entry data will be reviewed prior to re-issue and it is a like-for-like replacement. (ie. if two general landfill uses have already been used, the replacement pass will have two uses marked as already used.)
