#### **SUMMARY:**

This report recommends that the committee note the appointment of new brigade Fire Control Officers by the Shire following brigade elections.

## **5.2 A/CESM Mundaring/Chief Bush Fire Control Officer**

Approved burn prescriptions for:

- Charles/Coppin Rd, Mundaring Cell 2
- Charles/Coppin Rd, Mundaring Cell 1
- Liberton Rd, Chidlow
- Deconning Rd, Beechina
- Betty Street, UMR, Chidlow
- Bambrook St, Sawyers Valley

When weather is appropriate, the above burns will be carried out. Brigades will be called to support DFES when undertaking the burns, however notification will be at short notice.

## **5.3 Department Fire and Emergency Services**

### **• Mitigation Works**

\$1,315,000 has been given to North East region to mitigate 4 large parcels of land in the shire:

Darlington/Glen forest - \$620,000  
Mahogany Creek - \$525,000  
Mount Helena - \$100,000  
Chidlow Super Block - \$30,000

Another \$40,000 for other mitigation works around the Shire. Both Metropolitan Bushfire Risk Management Officers in conjunction with DO North East Mapped the 4 parcels and have identified required works.

- DFES is working on a CESM pool. This would be a list of people that could backfill the CESM when on leave. The pool would be reviewed each year.
- ICV working group is being established – this would take in all ICV's in the state with 2 delegates from each ICV Brigade.

Murray McBride introduced Dee Taylor (Volunteer Management Support Officer) to the meeting advising that although the role is still to be defined support to the CESM and DO will be provided.

## **5.4 Department Parks and Wildlife**

- Preparation for the 2019-20 fire season has commenced with scheduling of the departments mandatory pre-season training, medical and fire fitness
- In 2018-19 the Perth Hills district completed 39,777 ha of prescribed burning which 3,871 ha was in the Shire of Mundaring
- In 2018-19 the Perth Hills district attended 81 fires of which 16 were in the Shire of Mundaring. The biggest fire of those 16 was 10.9ha at Hudman Road Darlington on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019

## **5.5 Mundaring Fire School/Training Officers Committee**

Formal training run at the school since the last BFAC includes:

- ICV Crew Leader (9/10 June) – 3 attendees;
- Advanced Bushfire (08/09 June) – 7 attendees;
- WAERN Basic (15 June) – 5 attendees;
- WAERN Advanced (15 June) – 5 attendees;
- Pump Operations (15/16 June) – 5 attendees;
- Introduction to Firefighting (22 June) – 5 attendees;
- WAERN Basic (22 June) – 6 attendees, 1 no show;
- WAERN Advanced (22 June) – 6 attendees;
- Bushfire Firefighting (29 June) – 3 attendees;
- Structural Firefighting (6 July) – 8 attendees;
- Pump Operations (13 July) – 6 attendees;
- WAERN Basic (20 July) – 4 attendees;
- WAERN Advanced (20 July) – 4 attendees;
- Sector Command (20 July) – 10 attendees;
- Leadership Fundamentals (3 August) – 4 attendees, 1 no show;

Upcoming courses include:

- Incident Controller (Level 1) (17 August) – 6 applicants;
- Advanced Bush Fire Firefighting (24 August) – 14 applicants;
- Crew Leader Bush Fire (25 August) – 10 applicants;
- Introduction to Firefighting (14 September) – 2 applicants;
- Bush Fire Firefighting (21 September) – 4 applicants;
- Structural Firefighting (5 October) – 2 applicants;
- Introduction to Firefighting (26 October) – 0 applicants;

As you can see the number of applications for courses is still down so please remind all brigades to get their nominations in, so we do not have to cancel more courses.

On 30 and 31 July, MFS hosted a trial of the new DFES Introduction to Prescribed Fire course, Gary Rowles, Michael Logan and Neil Hawkins participated, the course was quite interesting, though all agreed that it was probably aimed a little too high for most bushfire brigade members. DFES is undertaking to roll out a course called Participate in Prescribed Burning which will be based on the National Competency and will probably suit brigades better.

It should be noted that our Mundaring Prescribed Fire course is probably equal to what DFES are proposing with the Participate course.

### **5.6.3 Infringements/Prosecutions**

Jeff Bromilow questioned why some cautions had been issued on days where the FDR was Very High or above. Craig Cuthbert said that cautions had been issued on 15 May 2019 to residents who were generally unaware

that the FDR had got to Very High on that day and were otherwise complying with permits that they had been issued. Offending residents were also issued warning letters along with the Caution Notices.

#### **5.6.4 Schedule of Pending Items**

##### **Mundaring Firefighters School**

Adrian Dyson said that on behalf of MFS he had submitted an internal Expression of Interest for the Stoneville Playgroup (located near Bentley Park) as a possible new location for the Mundaring Firefighters School. The building as it currently stands would require minor internal work (toilets etc) and will be put to Council for decision. Should the building be seen as a suitable location for MFS, Lotterywest would then be approached for a grant to build an "annex" beside the current structure.

##### **Stoneville Volunteer Bush Fire Brigade**

Adrian Dyson said that he had met with DFES Commissioner and Director of Finance around a new facility for the Stoneville VBFB as a prelude to a formal ESL/LGGS application for funding. It is envisaged that the new Station will be built on the same location as the currently station. It is envisaged at this stage that it would be a 3 bay station with some funding provided by DFES.

##### **BRMP Update**

Adrian Dyson advised the meeting that \$392,000 for the 19/20 Financial Year had been successfully applied for with works currently being organised.

#### **6.0 URGENT BUSINESS (LATE REPORTS)**

Adrian Dyson told that meeting that after two recent (separate) incidents where Shire of Mundaring Volunteers who were wearing BA at those incidents required medical treatment, an item has been provided to the Shire's Risk Management Committee which will hold its next meeting on 3 September 2019. The Item is in relation to the risk posed by Shire of Mundaring Volunteer Firefighters attending Structural Fires, with the need for these volunteers be trained to the same standard as VFRS brigades or that action be taken to not have BA brigades with the Shire of Mundaring.

Adrian Dyson re-iterated that raising this issue with the Shire Risk Committee has nothing to do with insurance and/or insurance costs.

Daniel Heptinstall said that he will continue to work with both Mt Helena and Parkerville brigades in regards to BA equipment and training.
