### **5.0 PRESENTATIONS**

#### **5.1 CESM Mundaring/Chief Bush Fire Control Officer**

I would firstly like to acknowledge the new members to BFAC and pass on appreciation to the previous membership.

Can I please express appreciation to brigades for their patience and cooperation throughout the COVID restrictions.

Although WA is in a fortunate situation I would encourage Brigades to continue to be vigilant in the personal distancing and Hygiene.

**Mitigation UCL/UMR** - UCL/UMR works ongoing with 108ha HRB conducted this season. Changes in current procedures have postponed some mitigation works in UCL/UMR.

HRBs planned in Glen Forrest, Chidlow and Mahogany Creek.

**Training** - Completed three (3) handover sessions for the Bush fire modules and the training has successfully been run.

ISFF course was planned for October but now cancelled due to lack of numbers.

Driver training – PUAVEH001A and TLIC3004- Drive HR vehicle, being conducted with approximately 41 SoM members programmed to attend.

**Operations** - Brigade Response for 2019/20 – 431 incidents attended by SoM Brigades.

**Pre-Season planning** – Brigades need to start working on pre-season training and equipment checks SoM currently overdue 6 Light Tankers with possible delivery of 4 this financial year.

## 5.2 Department Fire and Emergency Services

- UCL/UMR mitigation works in Mundaring Shire will be consisted mainly of burning.
- DFES's Bushfire Risk Management Officers, CESM and I are working on plans and dates to carry out hazard reduction burns in Darlington, Glen forest, Helena Valley and Mahogany Creek.
- Helena Collage – UCL Mitigation Burn and School drill – CFRS, BFB and DFES staff (Emergency Services Minister, FES Commissioner, DFES Media are showing interest)
- Metro North East Region is putting tentative plans in place for responding to incidents with COVID- 19 in mind.
- High Season appliances have been requested for Darlington and Mundaring VFRS, haven't heard if been successful as yet.
- Pagers will not be supported after the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020, only verbal confirmation at this stage. Vodaphone will no longer offer this service and there is no replacement system available.

### **5.4 Mundaring Fire School/Training Officers Committee**

There is little to report this month as our training season has only just started. The COVID-19 Pandemic put a sudden halt to all training when both DFES and the Shire enacted restrictions. The entire MFS calendar was cancelled, and we were all waiting for the go ahead to resume.

This occurred in late May and I sought input from the brigades so that we could ensure that their training priorities were met. The Management Committee met to develop a new calendar and we resumed training at the school on 4 July 2020 with a handover of the new Bush Fire Modules to existing Trainer Assessors. Twelve of our IFF and BFF T/As are now endorsed in the new modules.

There are significant changes to the way trainer/assessors present the information with almost all of the powerpoints being reduced to a handful of slides, relying on the trainer's subject knowledge and ability to follow the lesson plan rather than read off the slides. There is however a degree of flexibility in the content that needs to be presented allowing trainers to 'localise' certain content.

The biggest change for students is the increased reliance on practical skills and exercises rather than just knowledge. It is essential that students be given the opportunity to practise the skills at station, ideally before the course, but especially afterward. There is not enough time in a weekend for us to teach, practice and assess the physical skills and so we are relying on brigades to lock in the knowledge and skills as part of normal brigade activities.

It was disappointing that since we started up again three of the courses that brigades said were a priority have been cancelled due to a lack of nominations, I think that our members have become accustomed to staying home on the weekends over the past few months.



We successfully ran the new Bushfire Safety Awareness Course and have also run Leadership Fundamentals and Level 1 IC courses to date with the new Bush Firefighting Skills course set for next weekend (15-16 August). There has been a strong response from trainer assessors to sit in or participate in the new courses and I think those that have given up their time to ensure the new content is the best we can provide to our members.

All the MFS courses are loaded into eAcademy and I encourage brigades to help members book training early. Remember if rosters or schedules don't allow a member to do one of our courses they can apply for any course advertised at the FES Academy, or other local Governments.

We have left several free weekends in the calendar to allow for ad-hoc courses to be run, we also have the flexibility to run courses on station and/or during the week if necessary, so talk with your members and let us know if there is a specific need.

Finally, the Firefighters School will be holding its AGM on August 27 and Nigel Morgan has indicated his desire to step down as the Chairman. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Nigel for all his hard work over the years, he has achieved a significant amount and managed to influence both DFES and the Shire for the betterment of the school. So thank you Nigel.

An acknowledgement of thanks was given to Nigel Morgan for his years of service.

A discussion was held around infringements being issued to residents for burning on very high or extreme FDR days, even during the open burning season (and during a DFES declared Total Fire Ban). The meeting was told that Shire staff make decisions on what a fine will be issued for.

### **5.5.4 Schedule of Pending Items**

#### **(i) Combined Stoneville Volunteer Bush Fire Brigade/MFS Facility Proposal**

Adrian announced that the proposed new Stoneville Fire Station project can not yet commence as LGGs funding for the project has been denied.

DFES have advised that the project did not meet State priorities.

\$20 Million was allocated by the State, with \$19.7 Million being allocated to the replacement vehicles, with the Shire of Mundaring brigades to have 6 vehicles replaced, the first 4 being the oldest from Chidlow, Mt Helena, Stoneville and Wooroloo

An appeal will be lodge with DFES in regards to not receiving funding for the new Station. BFAC will continue to be updated through this process. Preliminary arrangements around converting the Stoneville Playgroup for Mundaring Fire School continues, with the bulk of the money for this project having been granted. Basic drawings have been prepared and quotations will now be sourced. BFAC will continue to be updated through this process.

Shire staff have met with the Glen Forrest Brigade in regards to their request for a station upgrade, advising the brigade that any renovations at Glen Forrest won't take place until after Stoneville Brigade has been upgraded.

(ii) **BRMP Update**

Adrian advised that the business case for a FTE Risk Management Officer had been denied by Council and will be put forward again next financial year.

Adrian advised that the Shire had received \$332,000 Mitigation Activity Fund (MAF) for mitigation works to be carried out on Crown Land vested within the Shire, with 16 projects being identified, during the 2020/21 financial year.
