#### 5.3 Department Parks and Wildlife

#### **Prescribed Burning**

Since the previous Shire of Mundaring BFAC meeting, no prescribed burning has been undertaken by Parks and Wildlife in the Shire of Mundaring due to winter weather conditions.

Parks and Wildlife will continue to monitor the weather conditions for the remainder of Winter and into Spring and will commence hazard reduction burning when the weather conditions allow.

Parks and Wildlife may commence hazard reduction burning shortly though the Urban Interface in the Shire of Mundaring. Selection of priority cells will be determined by the forecasted weather conditions.

#### **Fire Call Outs**

No fire call outs for Parks & Wildlife since the previous BFAC Meeting. Key notes

- Annual Pre-season training is complete for all fire staff at DBCA Perth Hills
   District
- Other scheduled annual operational training will continue for specialised roles over the next couple of months until the commencement of 2021-2022 fire season
- Currently the Parks & Wildlife Perth Hills District Fire roster for the 2021-2022 fire season is due to commence Oct 7<sup>th</sup> 2021 for all fire crews.

#### 5.4 Mundaring Fire School/Training Officers Committee – MFS Chairperson

The first half of the year has been completed with 18 courses and 159 students trained.

I attended the inaugural Bushfire Service Training Advisory Committee in July. There are some new training courses close to being ready for roll out from the BFCoE including, Fire Weather 1, Bushfire Fundamentals, and Plan and Conduct Simple Planned Burns, Fireline Construction (machine operators) and the Machine Supervision Course is under review.

Mundaring BTO's and Trainer/Assessors have been invited to visit the BFCoE, we are looking at organising a bus trip later this year.

Finally, there has been a concern raised related to the complexity of some student's dietary requests at courses. Can we please remind prospective

students that the meals supplied are prepared by volunteers from the CWA and consist of a meat and salad roll. Whilst the CWA ladies do their best to accommodate dietary requirements, they are unable to cater to complex requests so it may be safer for people who have very specific needs to bring their own lunch.
