2.0 ANNOUNCEMENT BY PRESIDING MEMBER WITHOUT DISCUSSION

The Deputy Chair handed the discussion over to Manager Community Safety & Emergency Management, Adrian Dyson who read the following statement to the meeting:

The minutes of the Captains and 1st Lieutenants meeting have been shared with me (I won't discuss the background to that)
Upon reading these, I am dismayed at what is written in that document (and what is not written) in that document ,as in, reading between the lines.
Firstly, if any of the representatives of the above forum feel the need, give yourselves a big high five..... Go ahead!, you have managed to "poked the bear".

In my opinion however, and in reference to item 6.1,

(6.1 " _____" reminded those present of the need for meetings of the Captains and 1st Lieutenants to be a forum for frank and open discussion of issues related to bushfire brigades. Attendees must be assured that information will not be disseminated outside of the meeting, including to representatives from the Shire of Mundaring, without the express authorisation from those present)

I feel there is a disturb ins (at best) and possibly harmful to the SoM Bush Fire Service association or background to that request.

I have had a similar discussion with one of our brigades in the past on this issue and my advice was/comments were:

- We at the Shire can take criticism and are happy to respond to and act on same. Indeed if matters are only discussed behind "closed doors" then how are the matters concerned to be resolved?.
- How is it that frank and open discussion is put at risk by information being made available to SoM? I personally can take it, as I am not here to make friends, I am also not here to take enemies.
- SoM Brigades are SoM entities "Established and Maintained" in accordance with the BF Act 1954. Get over that, it is a fact of life! Therefore, to withhold information from the Shire is unwise in any way, and potentially dangerous and damaging.

Further to that above, the motion/recommendation within item 6.1 of the minutes would/could effectively preclude any SoM employee who may also be a VBFB Captain or Lieutenant from being involved in the workings of that group. That is a ridiculous and unjustifiably discriminating notion.

I note however also that item 4.2 states:

"Minutes of the November 19 2019 meeting emailed to all brigades are, "all brigades" thus similarly required to hold these in a "top secret" "Not to be viewed by Shire staff" file.

What values/views does this model for the newer, less experienced players in VBFB leadership ranks? I will answer my own question in that regard. It promotes a "Shire vs Us" mentality and hampers the very necessary proper communication and full exchange of information between VBFB's, the Shire and DFES.

Why is it that a Shire Vs VBFB view being perpetuated, I don't know. Is it the Australian idiom to knock all levels of government at every opportunity? I suspect it may partly be due to long held "grudges" or grievances.

For the overall good of the SoM VBFB service and our/my community such grudges or grievances cannot be the justification for unjust, unhelpful, potentially damaging practises or behaviour. You can hang onto your grievances as long as you like, but don't bring them to your VBFB role. Your members, your community and all of us involved in this thing called "bushfire safety" deserve better.

You may not be aware of it, or choose to ignore it however Shire staff, particularly those within my team advocate for/push the barrow/argue for matters to improve/safeguard conditions/equipment/funding for VBFB, their members etc

This includes examples such as the likes of me arguing the toss against 3 DFES AC's and a Chief Super. I have fought issues and won with bods as high as state MP's. We do that because it is the "Good Fight" and the wins we achieve provide a level of job satisfaction. The issue at hand here provides anything but job satisfaction and is very demotivating. If you want another team to do this work, just say the word.

The Deputy Chair then read out the following provided by Mt Helena VBFB Captain, Brenden Scott:

- Mt Helena VBFB carried out a recruitment drive via social media and also flyers around the town and held an open day on the 22nd February 2020. This resulted in 6 people expressing interest in joining the brigade and 4 of those people came along to the brigades monthly meeting on Monday the 24th February 2020. Ideally it would be great to see the shire assist brigades in an annual recruitment drive around February if there has been a quiet fire season.
- At previous BFAC's there has been questions asked about the installation of the digital fire danger signs. At the last BFAC an update was they were being installed in December and the signs are not yet installed and we are now in February. The members of Mt Helena VBFB would like to know why these important community information signs have not yet been installed.

5.1 CESM Mundaring/Chief Bush Fire Control Officer

Mitigation UCL/UMR

- Helena Valley Firebreak works completed, continuing work in Mt Helena. Once complete contractor will move to Mahogany Creek
- Brigades are encouraged to conduct area familiarisation through the Helena Valley
- Burn plans will be written in the coming weeks for Helena Valley and several smaller UCL blocks for Brigades to carry out.

Training

- New IFF and BFF scheduled to be handed over in March 2020 until handover is complete the current IFF and BFF can be continue to be used.

Operations

- Deployments – Shire of Mundaring crews committed crews to eastern states and intrastate deployment. Please pass on thanks to those crews who gave up their time, in particular those who were away over the Christmas and New Year period.
- Work on the Risk 2 Resource has started which will look at our current resourcing capacity.

5.2 Department Fire and Emergency Services

- City of Swan and DFES have appointed a new CESM, Kelsi Wells. Kelsi started on the 10/02/2020
- UCL/UMR mitigation works in Mundaring Shire are 75% complete for the 2019/2020 financial year. Starting to investigate UCL/UMR works for 2020/2021 and costings.
- DFES's Bushfire Risk Management Officers and DFES DO are working on plans and dates to carry out hazard reduction burns in Darlington.
- ICV reference group has not progressed due to workloads in the high threat season, deployments and incidents. Will continue to work on the establishment of the State Wide ICV User Group in the coming months.
- Operational Fleet Project will keep running through 2020.
- Thank you to everyone that has deployed this fire season.

 - o 48 bushfire callouts this fire season in the Parks and Wildlife Perth Hills District
 - o 20 bushfire deployments out of district.

 - 5 x total fires since last BFAC meeting on November 27th 2019 (3 x Deliberate, 2 x Accidental)
