#### 1.0 OPENING PROCEDURES

#### 2.0 DECLARATION BY THE PRESIDENT

Section 2.29 requires that a person elected as an elector president has to make a declaration in the prescribed form before acting in the office (refer **Attachment 1**).

Regulation 13 of the *Local Government (Constitution) Regulations 1995* provides the prescribed form, Form 7, and the following (in part):

- (1) For the purposes of sections 2.29 and 2.42
  - [(a), (b) deleted]
  - (c) the form of declaration for a mayor, president, deputy mayor, deputy president or councillor is that in Form 7; ...
- (2) A declaration required by section 2.29 to be made by a person elected as a mayor or president is to be made before
  - (a) the immediate predecessor of the person in the office of mayor or president; or
  - (b) an authorised person. ...

(5) In this regulation —

**authorised person** means a person before whom a statutory declaration can be made under the Oaths, Affidavits and Statutory Declarations Act 2005.

Note: the Chief Executive Officer is an authorised person under the *Oaths, Affidavits and Statutory Declarations Act 2005*.

#### 3.0 SWEARING IN COUNCILLORS

In accordance with section 2.29 of the *Local Government Act 1995* and regulation 13 of the *Local Government (Constitution) Regulations 1996* a person elected as a councillor must make a declaration of office before acting in the office (refer **Attachment 2**).

Regulation 13 of the *Local Government (Constitution) Regulations 1995* provides the prescribed form, Form 7, and the following (in part):

- (3) A declaration required by section 2.29 to be made by a person elected as a councillor, deputy mayor or deputy president is to be made before an authorised person. ...
- (5) In this regulation —

**authorised person** means a person before whom a statutory declaration can be made under the Oaths, Affidavits and Statutory Declarations Act 2005.

Newly elected Councillors shall be invited to make their Declaration of Office, in accordance with section 13(1) and (3) above.

Note: the Chief Executive Officer is an authorised person under the Oaths, Affidavits and Statutory Declarations Act 2005.
