### WHAT WILL BE COLLECTED

- Green Waste Tree and shrub prunings Max length 1.5m. Max diameter 150mm (6 inches)
- Furniture and general waste Max length 1.8m
- Scrap Metal Max length 1.8m
  Wire bundled and secured
- White Goods maximum of 4
  DO NOT degas Fridges and Freezers
- Mattresses maximum of 3

#### WHAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED

- More than two cubic metres
- X Unsorted waste
- X All building materials
- Sand, soil or lawn
- Food or small household waste
- Gas bottles, fire extinguishers, EPIRBs or flares

- Car bodies, parts, tyres or batteries
- Asbestos or fibrous cement
- X Glass or mirrors
- Hazardous waste ie chemicals, oils, paints,pesticides etc
- Small items that need to be boxed or bagged

### **Bulk Verge Collection 2023**

Reduce illegal dumping and nuisance pickers by placing items on the verge of your property no earlier than 7 days prior to your collection date.

### **Mundaring and Chidlow Community Recycling Centres**

Shire of Mundaring residents with a waste service have access to the Community Recycling Centres. The Entry Pass allows for three loads of general waste and unlimited entries for green waste and recyclables. The pass automatically renews July 1 each year.

### Mathieson Road (Chidlow) Thursday to Sunday 8am – 4pm

Maximum load volume – 6x4 high sided trailer. Additional Waste Entry – \$65

Tyres – (Max five per visit) – Fees apply

Commercial waste, commercial vehicles or vehicles with a two tonne payload or greater are NOT permitted.
