Mundaring Hills Open Studios

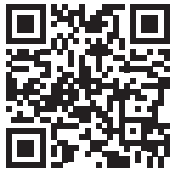
Mundaring Hills Open Studios is back this October and it's the biggest yet!

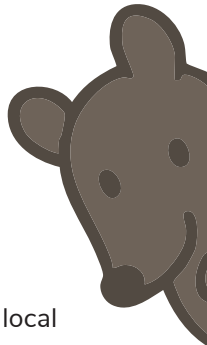
