## Nest boxes still supporting black cockatoos a decade on

More than 10 years after nest boxes were installed following the Parkerville, Stoneville and Mount Helena bushfires, they continue to play a vital role in supporting Endangered black cockatoos across the Shire of Mundaring.

First installed in 2015 in response to community concerns about wildlife loss after the 2014 fires, the artificial hollows have since helped dozens of Carnaby's and Forest Red-tailed Black Cockatoo


chicks successfully fledge. The project, delivered in partnership with local business ReCycOlogy and supported by volunteers and residents, remains a strong example of community-led conservation in action.


